Thank you for the explanation in regards to the rationing violations incurred by Dvorak's Expeditions on June 30<sup>th</sup> in Section 2B - Fisherman's Bridge to Stone Bridge, also July 26<sup>th</sup> and July 31<sup>st</sup> in Section 3 - Salida to Vallie Bridge. This notice is the invoice of the violation assessment for payment for the following Sections. Your violation is a tier-one violation for June 30<sup>th</sup> - \$25.00 per person, \$25.00 per raft - and tier-two for July 26<sup>th</sup> and July 31<sup>st</sup> - \$50.00 per person, \$50.00 per raft - **totaling \$650.00**. You will remain in tier-two for any future violations through 2014 - \$50.00 per person and boat.

For a Rationing Violation of \$1,000 or less, an Outfitter may elect to split the assessment into two (2) payments over a one (1) year period. A minimum of \$50.00 shall be submitted to AHRA on or before the first Payment Cycle (April 1<sup>st</sup> for preseason or November 1<sup>st</sup> for end of season) with the remainder due on the next scheduled payment cycle.

Your first payment was due on November 1, 2014.
