Thank you for your explanation in regards to the rationing violation incurred by Bill Dvoraks Kayak and Rafting Expeditions on July 25th in Section 2B, Fisherman's Bridge to Stone Bridge. This notice is the invoice of the violation assessment for payment. Your violation is a tier-one violation - \$25.00 per person, \$25.00 per kayak – **totaling \$25.00**. You will remain in tier-two for any future violations until July 25, 2013 - \$50.00 per person and boat.

For a Rationing Violation of \$1,000 or less, an Outfitter may elect to split the assessment into two (2) payments over a one (1) year period. A minimum of \$50.00 shall be submitted to AHRA on or before the first Payment Cycle (April 1st for preseason or November 1st for end of season) with the remainder due on the next scheduled payment cycle.

Your first payment will be due on November 1, 2012.
