Thank you for your explanations on the following rationing violations. This notice is the invoice for the violation assessment on payment. Your violations are tier-two violations for July 20<sup>th</sup>, July 22<sup>nd</sup> and September 1<sup>st</sup> - \$50.00 per person, \$50.00 per boat **totaling \$1,450.00**. You will return to Tier One (\$25.00 per person, \$25 per boat) for the 2014 season.

For a Rationing Violation assessment between \$1,001 and \$5,000, an Outfitter may elect to split the assessment into four (4) payments over a two (2) year period. 50% of the assessment shall be submitted to AHRA on or before (2) Payment Cycles (April 1<sup>st</sup> for preseason or November 1<sup>st</sup> for end of season) with the remainder due one (1) year thereafter. A minimum of \$50.00 shall be paid by the first Payment Cycle. If an Outfitter chooses to split the assessment, a 10% late fee will be assessed on the outstanding balance each year.

**Your first payment will be due on April 1, 2014.**
